## How Do We Remain Free From Sin?

1. When We Are Baptized We Become Free From Sin
2. do not let sin reign in your mortal body
3. present yourselves to God as those alive from the dead

## Present Yourselfes To God As Those Alive From The Dead

- As our thinking is governed by the gospel, Paul commands that we present ourselves to God as those alive from the dead, use our members to serve God rather than sin
- To be free from sin, we must continue to be slaves of righteousness every day
- Although our daily effort is required, we are saved and changed by the grace of God through His powerful gospel which transforms us into the image of His Son

## Present Yourselfes To God As Those Alive From The Dead

Rom 6:13 and do not go on presenting the members of your body to sin as instruments of unrighteousness; but present yourselves to God as those alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

Rom 6:14 For sin shall not be master over you, for you are not under law but under grace.

## Helping Others Become and Remain Free From Sin

- We are not to live the Christian life in isolation but are called to help others become and remain freed from sin
- When we are isolated from one another, there is a great chance we will return to slavery to sin
- As we appreciate freedom from sin by His gracious gospel, we will desire to help others to be free from sin by that same gospel

## Teach The Gospel To The Lost

Mar 16:15 And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.

Mar 16:16 "He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved; but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned.

## Teach The Gospel To The Lost

Act 2:38 Peter *said* to them, "Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

## Teach The Gospel To The Lost

Rom 6:3 Or do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus have been baptized into His death?

Rom 6:4 Therefore we have been buried with Him through baptism into death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, so we too might walk in newness of life.

## Teach The Gospel To The Lost

Rom 6:5 For if we have become united with *Him* in the likeness of His death, certainly we shall also be *in the likeness* of His resurrection,

Rom 6:6 knowing this, that our old self was crucified with *Him*, in order that our body of sin might be done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin;

Rom 6:7 for he who has died is freed from sin.

## Teach The Gospel To The Lost

Rom 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

Rom 1:17 For in it *the* righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "BUT THE RIGHTEOUS *man* SHALL LIVE BY FAITH."

## Believe And Pray God Can Change Others Through His Word

Col 1:9 For this reason also, since the day we heard *of it*, we have not ceased to pray for you and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding,

## Believe And Pray God Can Change Others Through His Word

Col 1:10 so that you will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, to please *Him* in all respects, bearing fruit in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

Col 1:11 strengthened with all power, according to His glorious might, for the attaining of all steadfastness and patience; joyously

## Believe And Pray God Can Change Others Through His Word

Col 1:12 giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to share in the inheritance of the saints in Light.

Col 1:13 For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son,

Col 1:14 in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

## Believe And Pray God Can Change Others Through His Word

Php 1:9 And this I pray, that your love may abound still more and more in real knowledge and all discernment,

Php 1:10 so that you may approve the things that are excellent, in order to be sincere and blameless until the day of Christ;

Php 1:11 having been filled with the fruit of righteousness which *comes* through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

## Pray For Others To Overcome Temptation

Eph 6:11 Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil.

Eph 6:18 With all prayer and petition pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with all perseverance and petition for all the saints,

## Pray For Others To Overcome Temptation

Eph 6:19 and *pray* on my behalf, that utterance may be given to me in the opening of my mouth, to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel,

Eph 6:20 for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in *proclaiming* it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

## Pray For Others To Overcome Temptation

Luk 22:31 "Simon, Simon, behold, Satan has demanded *permission* to sift you like wheat;

Luk 22:32 but I have prayed for you, that your faith may not fail; and you, when once you have turned again, strengthen your brothers."

## Pray For Others To Overcome Temptation

Luk 22:33 But he said to Him, "Lord, with You I am ready to go both to prison and to death!"

Luk 22:34 And He said, "I say to you, Peter, the rooster will not crow today until you have denied three times that you know Me."

## Build Up Others Through The Word of God

Mat 28:18 And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

Mat 28:19 "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit,

Mat 28:20 teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." 19

## Build Up Others Through The Word of God

Eph 4:11 And He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, and some as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers,

Eph 4:12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ;

## Build Up Others Through The Word of God

Eph 4:13 until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ.

Eph 4:14 As a result, we are no longer to be children, tossed here and there by waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, by craftiness in deceitful scheming; 21

## Build Up Others Through The Word of God

Eph 4:15 but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all *aspects* into Him who is the head, *even* Christ,

Eph 4:16 from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by what every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love. 22

## Build Up Others Through The Word of God

Tit 2:1 But as for you, speak the things which are fitting for sound doctrine.

Tit 2:2 Older men are to be temperate, dignified, sensible, sound in faith, in love, in perseverance.

Tit 2:3 Older women likewise are to be reverent in their behavior, not malicious gossips nor enslaved to much wine, teaching what is good, 23

## Build Up Others Through The Word of God

Tit 2:4 so that they may encourage the young women to love their husbands, to love their children,

Tit 2:5 *to be* sensible, pure, workers at home, kind, being subject to their own husbands, so that the word of God will not be dishonored.

Tit 2:6 Likewise urge the young men to be sensible; 24

## Build Up Others Through The Word of God

Tit 2:7 in all things show yourself to be an example of good deeds, *with* purity in doctrine, dignified,

Tit 2:8 sound *in* speech which is beyond reproach, so that the opponent will be put to shame, having nothing bad to say about us.

## Build Up Others Through The Word of God

Tit 2:9 *Urge* bondslaves to be subject to their own masters in everything, to be well-pleasing, not argumentative,

Tit 2:10 not pilfering, but showing all good faith so that they will adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in every respect.

## Worship God Together

Joh 4:24 "God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

Act 2:41 So then, those who had received his word were baptized; and that day there were added about three thousand souls.

Act 2:42 They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

## Worship God Together

Act 20:7 On the first day of the week, when we were gathered together to break bread, Paul *began* talking to them, intending to leave the next day, and he prolonged his message until midnight.

Act 12:5 So Peter was kept in the prison, but prayer for him was being made fervently by the church to God.

## Worship God Together

Col 3:16 Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms *and* hymns *and* spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

## Worship God Together

1Co 16:1 Now concerning the collection for the saints, as I directed the churches of Galatia, so do you also.

1Co 16:2 On the first day of every week each one of you is to put aside and save, as he may prosper, so that no collections be made when I come.

## By His Grace Love and Serve Others

Tit 2:11 For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation to all men,

Tit 2:12 instructing us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires and to live sensibly, righteously and godly in the present age,

## By His Grace Love and Serve Others

Tit 2:13 looking for the blessed hope and the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior, Christ Jesus,

Tit 2:14 who gave Himself for us to redeem us from every lawless deed, and to purify for Himself a people for His own possession, zealous for good deeds.

## By His Grace Love and Serve Others

Heb 10:24 and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds,

Heb 10:25 not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging *one another*; and all the more as you see the day drawing near.

## By His Grace Love and Serve Others

Joh 13:12 So when He had washed their feet, and taken His garments and reclined at *the table* again, He said to them, "Do you know what I have done to you?"

Joh 13:13 "You call Me Teacher and Lord; and you are right, for so I am.

Joh 13:14 "If I then, the Lord and the Teacher, washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet.

## By His Grace Love and Serve Others

Joh 13:15 "For I gave you an example that you also should do as I did to you.

Joh 13:16 "Truly, truly, I say to you, a slave is not greater than his master, nor *is* one who is sent greater than the one who sent him.

Joh 13:17 "If you know these things, you are blessed if you do them.

## By His Grace Love and Serve Others

Joh 13:34 "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

Joh 13:35 "By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another."

## By His Grace Love and Serve Others

1Co 13:4 Love is patient, love is kind *and* is not jealous; love does not brag *and* is not arrogant,

1Co 13:5 does not act unbecomingly; it does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong *suffered*,

1Co 13:6 does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth;

1Co 13:7 bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. 40

## Rejoice Together Living The Christian Life

Act 5:27 When they had brought them, they stood them before the Council. The high priest questioned them,

Act 5:28 saying, "We gave you strict orders not to continue teaching in this name, and yet, you have filled Jerusalem with your teaching and intend to bring this man's blood upon us."

## Rejoice Together Living The Christian Life

Act 5:29 But Peter and the apostles answered, "We must obey God rather than men.

Act 5:30 "The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom you had put to death by hanging Him on a cross.

## Rejoice Together Living The Christian Life

Act 5:31 "He is the one whom God exalted to His right hand as a Prince and a Savior, to grant repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins.

Act 5:32 "And we are witnesses of these things; and *so is* the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey Him."

## Rejoice Together Living The Christian Life

Act 5:40 They took his advice; and after calling the apostles in, they flogged them and ordered them not to speak in the name of Jesus, and *then* released them.

Act 5:41 So they went on their way from the presence of the Council, rejoicing that they had been considered worthy to suffer shame for *His* name.

## Rejoice Together Living The Christian Life

Act 5:42 And every day, in the temple and from house to house, they kept right on teaching and preaching Jesus as the Christ.

Act 16:25 But about midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns of praise to God, and the prisoners were listening to them;

## Rejoice Together Living The Christian Life

1Pe 4:15 Make sure that none of you suffers as a murderer, or thief, or evildoer, or a troublesome meddler;

1Pe 4:16 but if *anyone suffers* as a Christian, he is not to be ashamed, but is to glorify God in this name.

## Rejoice Together Living The Christian Life

1Co 12:26 And if one member suffers, all the members suffer with it; if *one* member is honored, all the members rejoice with it.

47

## Forgive Others

Mat 6:14 "For if you forgive others for their transgressions, your heavenly Father will also forgive you.

Mat 6:15 "But if you do not forgive others, then your Father will not forgive your transgressions.

## Forgive Others

Eph 4:31 Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice.

Eph 4:32 Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

## Bear The Burdens of Others

Gal 6:2 Bear one another's burdens, and thereby fulfill the law of Christ.

Gal 6:3 For if anyone thinks he is something when he is nothing, he deceives himself.

Gal 6:4 But each one must examine his own work, and then he will have *reason for* boasting in regard to himself alone, and not in regard to another.

Gal 6:5 For each one will bear his own load.

## Humbly Restore Others Back To The Lord

Gal 6:1 Brethren, even if anyone is caught in any trespass, you who are spiritual, restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness; *each one* looking to yourself, so that you too will not be tempted.

## Humbly Restore Others Back To The Lord

Jas 5:16 Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.

Jas 5:17 Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the earth for three years and six months.

## Humbly Restore Others Back To The Lord

Jas 5:18 Then he prayed again, and the sky poured rain and the earth produced its fruit.

Jas 5:19 My brethren, if any among you strays from the truth and one turns him back,

Jas 5:20 let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save his soul from death and will cover a multitude of sins.

## Humbly Restore Others Back To The Lord

1Co 5:1 It is actually reported that there is immorality among you, and immorality of such a kind as does not exist even among the Gentiles, that someone has his father's wife.

1Co 5:2 You have become arrogant and have not mourned instead, so that the one who had done this deed would be removed from your midst.

## Humbly Restore Others Back To The Lord

1Co 5:5 *I have decided* to deliver such a one to Satan for the destruction of his flesh, so that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.

1Co 5:11 But actually, I wrote to you not to associate with any so-called brother if he is an immoral person, or covetous, or an idolater, or a reviler, or a drunkard, or a swindler--not even to eat with such a one.

## Humbly Restore Others Back To The Lord

2Th 3:10 For even when we were with you, we used to give you this order: if anyone is not willing to work, then he is not to eat, either.

2Th 3:14 If anyone does not obey our instruction in this letter, take special note of that person and do not associate with him, so that he will be put to shame.

2Th 3:15 *Yet* do not regard him as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother.

## Humbly Restore Others Back To The Lord

2Co 2:8 Wherefore I urge you to reaffirm *your* love for him.

2Co 2:9 For to this end also I wrote, so that I might put you to the test, whether you are obedient in all things.

## Humbly Restore Others Back To The Lord

2Co 2:10 But one whom you forgive anything, I *forgive* also; for indeed what I have forgiven, if I have forgiven anything, *I did it* for your sakes in the presence of Christ,

2Co 2:11 so that no advantage would be taken of us by Satan, for we are not ignorant of his schemes.
