Immorality

- Immorality then would cover all sexual sins such as adultery (including adulterous marriages defined by God), homosexuality, incest, premarital sexual relations, prostitution, bestiality and so on
- Like today, the first century Greco-roman world saw no shame in fornication which was common among all levels of society and even often associated with idolatrous religion like in Corinth

Immorality

- Immorality is where people use others for the gratification of their own lusts
- Christians are warned to flee immorality and pursue purity of heart and sexual relations only in Scriptural marriages

Immorality

Mat 19:3 Some Pharisees came to Jesus, testing Him and asking, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any reason at all?"

Mat 19:4 And He answered and said, "Have you not read that He who created them from the beginning MADE THEM MALE AND FEMALE,

Immorality

Mat 19:5 and said, 'FOR THIS REASON A MAN SHALL LEAVE HIS FATHER AND MOTHER AND BE JOINED TO HIS WIFE, AND THE TWO SHALL BECOME ONE FLESH'?

Mat 19:6 "So they are no longer two, but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let no man separate."

Mat 19:7 They *said to Him, "Why then did Moses command to GIVE HER A CERTIFICATE OF DIVORCE AND SEND her AWAY?"

Rom 7:2 For the married woman is bound by law to her husband while he is living; but if her husband dies, she is released from the law concerning the husband.

Impurity

- Originally, it referred to physical dirt, such as tenants not leaving their rented residence dirty
- Later, it came to mean moral impurity or uncleanness, that evil thinking that separates us from God and leads to other sins

Impurity

Mat 23:25 "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you clean the outside of the cup and of the dish, but inside they are full of robbery and self-indulgence.

Mat 23:26 "You blind Pharisee, first clean the inside of the cup and of the dish, so that the outside of it may become clean also.

Impurity

Mat 23:27 "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs which on the outside appear beautiful, but inside they are full of dead men's bones and all uncleanness.

Mat 23:28 "So you, too, outwardly appear righteous to men, but inwardly you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness.

Impurity

Mat 5:8 "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

Eph 5:3 But immorality or any impurity or greed must not even be named among you, as is proper among saints;

Impurity

Eph 5:4 and there must be no filthiness and silly talk, or coarse jesting, which are not fitting, but rather giving of thanks.

Sensuality

- It is shameless, uncontrolled behavior focused on sexual sins which is often displayed in public without regard to respecting God or others
- It would include modern dance, much in music, theater and displays of a sexual nature
- Christians are to put these away and put on Christ

Sensuality

Rom 13:11 Do this, knowing the time, that it is already the hour for you to awaken from sleep; for now salvation is nearer to us than when we believed.

Rom 13:12 The night is almost gone, and the day is near. Therefore let us lay aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light.

41

Sensuality

Rom 13:13 Let us behave properly as in the day, not in carousing and drunkenness, not in sexual promiscuity and sensuality, not in strife and jealousy.

Rom 13:14 But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh in regard to its lusts.

Sensuality

1Pe 4:1 Therefore, since Christ has suffered in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same purpose, because he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin,

Idolatry

- People claim idols are simply a representation of God to help worship Him
- But, people then began to exalt and worship the images
- Idolatry refers not only to images but to anyone or anything we place above God such as money, house, job or recreation
- Christians must worship God only and flee idolatry

Idolatry

Rom 1:18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness,

Rom 1:19 because that which is known about God is evident within them; for God made it evident to them.

Idolatry

Rom 1:20 For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse.

Rom 1:21 For even though they knew God, they did not honor Him as God or give thanks, but they became futile in their speculations, and their foolish heart was darkened.

Rom 1:22 Professing to be wise, they became fools,

Sorcery

- We get our word pharmacy from this word indicating medical use of drugs for good
- Also, the word came to signify poisons that could be used for harm
- Finally, the word can refer to sorcery or witchcraft where drugs are used to cast spells, alter moods and behavior of others
- "Recreational" drugs today such as alcohol, marijuana and heroin would fall into this group
- We must be sober and have self-control 56

Sorcery

Rev 9:20 The rest of mankind, who were not killed by these plagues, did not repent of the works of their hands, so as not to worship demons, and the idols of gold and of silver and of brass and of stone and of wood, which can neither see nor hear nor walk;

Rev 9:21 and they did not repent of their murders nor of their sorceries nor of their immorality nor of their thefts.

Enmities

- When we study agape, love, later, we will see it means sacrificing for the good of others, doing good and never doing harm to others
- While enmities or hatred involves creating hostile barriers between others, doing evil toward others

Enmities

Eph 2:14 For He Himself is our peace, who made both groups into one and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall,

Eph 2:15 by abolishing in His flesh the enmity, which is the Law of commandments contained in ordinances, so that in Himself He might make the two into one new man, thus establishing peace,

Eph 2:16 and might reconcile them both in one body to God through the cross, by it having put to death the enmity.

Enmities

1Jn 3:15 Everyone who hates his brother is a murderer; and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him.

Strife

- While enmities focus on the underlying attitude of hatred toward others, strife focuses on the outward results of enmities or hatred
- This is displayed in all types of relationships such as marriages parents and children and unfortunately local churches
- Often, churches may stand against sexual sins while allowing strife to go unchecked

Strife

Rom 1:28 And just as they did not see fit to acknowledge God any longer, God gave them over to a depraved mind, to do those things which are not proper,

Rom 1:29 being filled with all unrighteousness, wickedness, greed, evil; full of envy, murder, strife, deceit, malice; they are gossips,

Strife

1Co 1:10 Now I exhort you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all agree and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be made complete in the same mind and in the same judgment.

1Co 1:11 For I have been informed concerning you, my brethren, by Chloe's people, that there are quarrels among you.

Strife

Jealousy

- Jealousy or zeal can either be good or bad
- Being fervent in spirit for God coupled with knowledge is good
- Being zealous to protect and defend others is good
- Being zealous or jealous for self to exalt above others, in rivalry with them is sinful and must be crucified to please God

Jealousy

2Co 11:2 For I am jealous for you with a godly jealousy; for I betrothed you to one husband, so that to Christ I might present you as a pure virgin.

2Co 11:3 But I am afraid that, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, your minds will be led astray from the simplicity and purity of devotion to Christ.

Jealousy

1Co 3:1 And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual men, but as to men of flesh, as to infants in Christ.

Outbursts of Anger

- The NIV translates this with fits of rage
- It refers to sinful short explosions of anger that erupt but die out fairly quickly
- The Christian must crucify this type of uncontrolled anger

Outbursts of Anger

Act 19:28 When they heard this and were filled with rage, they began crying out, saying, "Great is Artemis of the Ephesians!"

Eph 4:31 Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice.

Eph 4:32 Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you.

Disputes

- Often, we see selfish ambition or disputes in the political area
- Win at any cost thinking only of elevating self and using others to get there
- But, we can see it in other areas of life including a local church, serving God to elevate self, in rivalry against others

Disputes

Php 2:3 Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind regard one another as more important than yourselves;

Php 2:4 do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.

Php 2:5 Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus,

Disputes

Php 2:6 who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped,

Php 2:7 but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men.

Php 2:8 Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

Dissensions

- This refers to those who cause division in the church for sinful reasons
- They follow false teachings, seek to gather followers to elevate themselves, turn personal grudges into reasons for dividing and so on
- We are to observe and withdraw from these if they do not repent of their divisive attitudes

Dissensions

Rom 16:17 Now I urge you, brethren, keep your eye on those who cause dissensions and hindrances contrary to the teaching which you learned, and turn away from them.

Rom 16:18 For such men are slaves, not of our Lord Christ but of their own appetites; and by their smooth and flattering speech they deceive the hearts of the unsuspecting.

Factions

- The word refers to the forming of groups who follow various false teachings such as the Pharisees and Sadducees among the Jews
- These factions cannot be in fellowship with anyone except their own kind

Act 15:5 But some of the sect of the Pharisees who had believed stood up, saying, "It is necessary to circumcise them and to direct them to observe the Law of Moses."

1Co 11:19 For there must also be factions among you, so that those who are approved may become evident among you.

Envy

- While jealousy or zeal can either be good or bad, envy can only be sinful
- While jealousy or zeal may seek to exalt self in rivalry against another, envy goes a step further and tries to act in hostility toward those who seem to have advantage or prosper

Drunkenness

- Drunkenness then means the condition of being intoxicated by alcohol
- The Scriptures clearly condemn this as sin
- Due to fortified alcohol levels surpassing ancient levels by far, it is very easy to get drunk even if not intended
- Also, Christians must never misuse their influence (through social drinking) to lead others to drink alcohol and possibly fall into sin
