- Although his primary work would be in the revelation and confirmation of the written New Testament, He was also active during Jesus' life on earth
- We are not given exact details about how the Holy Spirit worked in Jesus' life
- However, it is clear that the Holy Spirit, along with the Father, worked with Jesus as one while He was on earth to accomplish God's plan of salvation

His miraculous conception and birth

Luk 1:30 The angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary; for you have found favor with God.

Luk 1:31 "And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name Him Jesus.

Luk 1:32 "He will be great and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David;

Luk 1:33 and He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and His kingdom will have no end."

Luk 1:34 Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I am a virgin?"

Luk 1:35 The angel answered and said to her, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; and for that reason the holy Child shall be called the Son of God. 7

His miraculous conception and birth

Luk 1:36 "And behold, even your relative Elizabeth has also conceived a son in her old age; and she who was called barren is now in her sixth month.

Luk 1:37 "For nothing will be impossible with God."

His miraculous conception and birth

Mat 1:18 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was as follows: when His mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child by the Holy Spirit.

Mat 1:19 And Joseph her husband, being a righteous man and not wanting to disgrace her, planned to send her away secretly.

Mat 1:20 But when he had considered this, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife; for the Child who has been conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit.

Mat 1:21 "She will bear a Son; and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins."

His miraculous conception and birth

Mat 1:22 Now all this took place to fulfill what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet:

Mat 1:23 "BEHOLD, THE VIRGIN SHALL BE WITH CHILD AND SHALL BEAR A SON, AND THEY SHALL CALL HIS NAME IMMANUEL," which translated means, "GOD WITH US."

His miraculous conception and birth

Mat 1:24 And Joseph awoke from his sleep and did as the angel of the Lord commanded him, and took *Mary* as his wife, Mat 1:25 but kept her a virgin until she gave birth to a Son; and he called His name Jesus.

His baptism at the beginning of His ministry

Mat 3:16 After being baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending as a dove *and* lighting on Him,

Mat 3:17 and behold, a voice out of the heavens said, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well-pleased."

His baptism at the beginning of His ministry

Luk 3:21 Now when all the people were baptized, Jesus was also baptized, and while He was praying, heaven was opened,

Luk 3:22 and the Holy Spirit descended upon Him in bodily form like a dove, and a voice came out of heaven, "You are My beloved Son, in You I am well-pleased."

His baptism at the beginning of His ministry

Joh 1:31 "I did not recognize Him, but so that He might be manifested to Israel, I came baptizing in water."

Joh 1:32 John testified saying, "I have seen the Spirit descending as a dove out of heaven, and He remained upon Him.

His baptism at the beginning of His ministry

Joh 1:33 "I did not recognize Him, but He who sent me to baptize in water said to me, 'He upon whom you see the Spirit descending and remaining upon Him, this is the One who baptizes in the Holy Spirit.'

Joh 1:34 "I myself have seen, and have testified that this is the Son of God."

Leading Him

Luk 4:1 Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led around by the Spirit in the wilderness

Luk 4:2 for forty days, being tempted by the devil. And He ate nothing during those days, and when they had ended, He became hungry.

His teaching

Joh 3:34 "For He whom God has sent speaks the words of God; for He gives the Spirit without measure.

Joh 3:35 "The Father loves the Son and has given all things into His hand.

His teaching

Luk 4:14 And Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the Spirit, and news about Him spread through all the surrounding district.

Luk 4:15 And He *began* teaching in their synagogues and was praised by all.

Luk 4:17 And the book of the prophet Isaiah was handed to Him. And He opened the book and found the place where it was written,

His teaching

Luk 4:18 "THE SPIRIT OF THE LORD IS UPON ME, BECAUSE HE ANOINTED ME TO PREACH THE GOSPEL TO THE POOR. HE HAS SENT ME TO PROCLAIM RELEASE TO THE CAPTIVES, AND RECOVERY OF SIGHT TO THE BLIND, TO SET FREE THOSE WHO ARE OPPRESSED,

Luk 4:19 TO PROCLAIM THE FAVORABLE YEAR OF THE LORD."

His teaching

Luk 4:20 And He closed the book, gave it back to the attendant and sat down; and the eyes of all in the synagogue were fixed on Him.

Luk 4:21 And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture has been fulfilled in your hearing."

His teaching

Act 1:1 The first account I composed, Theophilus, about all that Jesus began to do and teach,

Act 1:2 until the day when He was taken up *to heaven*, after He had by the Holy Spirit given orders to the apostles whom He had chosen.

His teaching

Mat 12:17 *This was* to fulfill what was spoken through Isaiah the prophet:

Mat 12:18 "BEHOLD, MY SERVANT WHOM I HAVE CHOSEN; MY BELOVED IN WHOM MY SOUL is WELL-PLEASED; I WILL PUT MY SPIRIT UPON HIM, AND HE SHALL PROCLAIM JUSTICE TO THE GENTILES.

His teaching

Mat 12:19 "HE WILL NOT QUARREL, NOR CRY OUT; NOR WILL ANYONE HEAR HIS VOICE IN THE STREETS.

Mat 12:20 "A BATTERED REED HE WILL NOT BREAK OFF, AND A SMOLDERING WICK HE WILL NOT PUT OUT, UNTIL HE LEADS JUSTICE TO VICTORY.

Mat 12:21 "AND IN HIS NAME THE GENTILES WILL HOPE."

His miracles

Mat 12:24 But when the Pharisees heard *this*, they said, "This man casts out demons only by Beelzebul the ruler of the demons."

Mat 12:25 And knowing their thoughts Jesus said to them, "Any kingdom divided against itself is laid waste; and any city or house divided against itself will not stand.

Mat 12:26 "If Satan casts out Satan, he is divided against himself; how then will his kingdom stand?"

His miracles

Mat 12:27 "If I by Beelzebul cast out demons, by whom do your sons cast *them* out? For this reason they will be your judges.

Mat 12:28 "But if I cast out demons by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.

His miracles

Mat 12:29 "Or how can anyone enter the strong man's house and carry off his property, unless he first binds the strong *man*? And then he will plunder his house.

Act 10:38 "*You know of* Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and *how* He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

His miracles

Joh 20:30 Therefore many other signs Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book;

Joh 20:31 but these have been written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name.

His death and resurrection

Heb 9:14 how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Rom 8:11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.
