Introduction

- Scriptures plainly teach of Jesus building only one church with Him as its only head
- Confusion has come because of misunderstanding about
 - Nature of Jesus' headship
 - Nature of Jesus' church
- Understanding how Jesus is head and what Jesus is head of is essential for only those in His church will be saved

Jesus Will Save Only Members of His One Church

Eph 1:22 And He put all things in subjection under His feet, and gave Him as head over all things to the church,

Eph 1:23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

Eph 4:4 *There is* one body and one Spirit, just as also you were called in one hope of your calling;

What Does Head Mean?

- Head is a figure of speech describing Jesus' position of authority over His church
- Parallel to human head (brain) being in absolute control of human body (individual parts)
- Jesus is now head over His one church, has absolute authority to control all members

Jesus Now Absolute Head of His One Church

Eph 5:22 Wives, *be subject* to your own husbands, as to the Lord.

Eph 5:23 For the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the head of the church, He Himself *being* the Savior of the body.

Eph 5:24 But as the church is subject to Christ, so also the wives *ought to be* to their husbands in everything.

How Did Jesus Become Head?

- Jesus foretold he would build His one church
- First He became savior of His one church by dying for our sins
- Then, the Father raised Him from the dead, proving Him to be savior and giving Him all authority as King of all and head of His one church

Jesus Foretold He Would Build His One Church

Mat 16:15 He *said to them, "But who do you say that I am?"

Mat 16:16 Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

Mat 16:17 And Jesus said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Barjona, because flesh and blood did not reveal *this* to you, but My Father who is in heaven.

Mat 16:18 "I also say to you that you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build My church; and the gates of Hades will not overpower it.

Jesus' Death For Forgiveness of Sins – Save His One Church

How Does Jesus Communicate As Head?

- Jesus foretold the apostles would be guided by the Holy Spirit so they could speak and teach all truth
- Written Word, New Testament, we have today is the will of Jesus, the head, expressed through apostles and other inspired men

False Ideas About How Jesus Communicates As Head

- False Catholic idea The Pope, Christ's representative, is successor of apostles and has the right to bind his words on people today
- They view Peter as above other apostles and Pope is successor of Peter
- Pentecostal false idea Holy Spirit speaks directly to us today apart from written Word

What Are Some Characterizes of His Headship?

Absolute authority

Eph 1:22 And He put all things in subjection under His feet, and gave Him as head over all things to the church,

Eph 1:23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

What Are Some Characterizes of His Headship?

Body has no right to function unless directed by the head

the Savior of the body.

Eph 5:24 But as the church is subject to Christ, so also the wives *ought to be* to their husbands in everything.

Both loving and authoritative head Eph 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her,

What Is His Body, His One Church?

- Body is a figure of speech used to describe Jesus' one church
- Jesus as head controls, rules over His one church
- Jesus' one church, His body, is composed of individuals who have submitted themselves to Him and who He has saved
- Jesus' one body, His church is that assembly of individuals who He saves by His gospel

Jesus Rules Over His Body, His One Church

Eph 5:23 For the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the head of the church, He Himself *being* the Savior of the body.

Jesus' Body, His One Church, Composed of Individuals

1Co 12:12 For even as the body is one and *yet* has many members, and all the members of the body, though they are many, are one body, so also is Christ.

Catholic View of Jesus' One Church

- Church is universal organization composed of local groups that has a centralized leadership, the Pope and college of cardinals
- Church is between Christ and men dispensing blessing on members and revealing truth to them

Catholic View of Jesus' One Church

1CO 12:13 For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.

ACT 20:28 "Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

Protestant View of Jesus' One Church

- Universal organization composed of denominations
- Denomination is a group of local churches that work together as "one"
- Many denominations have centralized leaderships
- Result is a body of bodies that contradict one another in name, organization, teaching and practice

Protestant View of Jesus' One Church

1CO 12:13 For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.

1Co 4:17 For this reason I have sent to you Timothy, who is my beloved and faithful child in the Lord, and he will remind you of my ways which are in Christ, just as I teach everywhere in every church.

Some Churches of Christ' View of Jesus' One Church

- Universal organization composed of local churches
- These local churches work together as "one" through either human institutions or sponsoring churches
- A sponsoring church is a local church that oversees the work of other local churches.

Biblical' View of Jesus' One Church

- His church is not an institution but a collection of people from all nations that come to Him on the same terms of obedience to the gospel and remain faithful to him by following the same teaching, the teaching of His apostles
- Members of His body meet together in various locations and function as local churches only as the head directs them to do

Biblical' View of Jesus' One Church

1CO 12:13 For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one Spirit.

ACT 20:28 "Be on guard for yourselves and for all the flock, among which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers, to shepherd the church of God which He purchased with His own blood.

His Body Subject To Him, Its Head

- Concerning how to be saved and how to work and worship together as a local church, we must be subject to only Jesus as head, following His written Word
- Also, in all areas of our lives, we must yield to the head's authority

His Body Subject To Him, Its Head

Eph 5:24 But as the church is subject to Christ, so also the wives *ought to be* to their husbands in everything.

Act 2:41 So then, those who had received his word were baptized; and that day there were added about three thousand souls.

Act 2:42 They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

His Body Subject To Him, Its Head

Col 3:16 Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms *and* hymns *and* spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

Col 3:17 Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.

Col 3:18 Wives, be subject to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.

His Body Subject To Him, Its Head

Col 3:19 Husbands, love your wives and do not be embittered against them.

Col 3:20 Children, be obedient to your parents in all things, for this is well-pleasing to the Lord.

Col 3:21 Fathers, do not exasperate your children, so that they will not lose heart.

How Do We Become Members of His Body, His One Church?

- Because Jesus will only save those who are members of His one church, His body, it is essential we become a part of that one body
- This happens when we obey the gospel to become saved or forgiven, Jesus adds us to His one church
- To remain in His body, we must be faithful to the apostles teaching, rejecting Catholicism and Protestantism

Local Churches Are Not Members of His Body

- A local church is a group of saints meeting in a given area to work and worship as the Lord, the head, commands
- These local churches are composed of individual members of the body but as organizational units they are not individual units of the Lord's body. That is denominationalism, seeing the Lord's church as a group of local churches

Jesus' Authority As Head Applies To Our Daily Lives

Unity Comes As Members Submit To Him As Head

- No centralized earthly headship authorized to enforce unity in Jesus' body
- Unity among members of His body comes when members voluntarily submit to the head

Eph 4:1 Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called,

Eph 4:2 with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love.
