The most important question we can ask but sadly it is often answered in the wrong way

## How Did We Become Lost?

- Contrary to popular belief, we are not lost because we are born in sin, guilty at birth of Adam's or our parents' sins
- We become lost when we choose to commit sin, violate God's law
- When we sin, we become separated from God, spiritually dead, condemned and in need of salvation which only God can provide

## We Are Not Born Guilty of Sin

Eze 18:20 "The person who sins will die. The son will not bear the punishment for the father's iniquity, nor will the father bear the punishment for the son's iniquity; the righteousness of the righteous will be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked will be upon himself.

## We Are Not Born Guilty of Sin

Mat 18:2 And He called a child to Himself and set him before them,

Mat 18:3 and said, "Truly I say to you, unless you are converted and become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven.

Mat 18:4 "Whoever then humbles himself as this child, he is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.

## We Sin When We Choose To Violate God's Law

1Jn 3:4 Everyone who practices sin also practices lawlessness; and sin is lawlessness.

1Jn 5:17 All unrighteousness is sin, and there is a sin not leading to death.

## We Sin When We Choose To Violate God's Law

Rom 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Jas 4:17 Therefore, to one who knows the right thing to do and does not do it, to him it is sin.

## We Sin When We Choose To Violate God's Law

Gen 4:1 Now the man had relations with his wife Eve, and she conceived and gave birth to Cain, and she said, "I have gotten a manchild with the help of the LORD."

Gen 4:2 Again, she gave birth to his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of flocks, but Cain was a tiller of the ground.

## We Sin When We Choose To Violate God's Law

Gen 4:3 So it came about in the course of time that Cain brought an offering to the LORD of the fruit of the ground.

Gen 4:4 Abel, on his part also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of their fat portions. And the LORD had regard for Abel and for his offering;

Gen 4:5 but for Cain and for his offering He had no regard. So Cain became very angry and his countenance fell.

Gen 4:6 Then the LORD said to Cain, "Why are you angry? And why has your countenance fallen?"

## We Sin When We Choose To Violate God's Law

Gen 4:7 "If you do well, will not your countenance be lifted up? And if you do not do well, sin is crouching at the door; and its desire is for you, but you must master it."

Gen 4:8 Cain told Abel his brother. And it came about when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother and killed him.

## Our Own Sins Separate Us From God Make Us Spiritually Dead

Isa 59:1 Behold, the LORD'S hand is not so short That it cannot save; Nor is His ear so dull That it cannot hear.

Isa 59:2 But your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, And your sins have hidden His face from you so that He does not hear.

## Our Own Sins Separate Us From God Make Us Spiritually Dead

Rom 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

## But We Can Also Choose To Have Faith In God

Heb 11:1 Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.

Heb 11:4 By faith Abel offered to God a better sacrifice than Cain, through which he obtained the testimony that he was righteous, God testifying about his gifts, and through faith, though he is dead, he still speaks.

## But We Can Also Choose To Have Faith In God

Heb 11:6 And without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who seek Him.

Rom 10:17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.

## God Will Forgive Us No Matter How Sinful We Have Been

1Ti 1:12 I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has strengthened me, because He considered me faithful, putting me into service,

1Ti 1:13 even though I was formerly a blasphemer and a persecutor and a violent aggressor. Yet I was shown mercy because I acted ignorantly in unbelief;

## God Will Forgive Us No Matter How Sinful We Have Been

1Ti 1:14 and the grace of our Lord was more than abundant, with the faith and love which are found in Christ Jesus.

1Ti 1:15 It is a trustworthy statement, deserving full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, among whom I am foremost of all.

## God Will Forgive Us No Matter How Sinful We Have Been

1Ti 1:16 Yet for this reason I found mercy, so that in me as the foremost, Jesus Christ might demonstrate His perfect patience as an example for those who would believe in Him for eternal life.

1. He sent Jesus to die for our sins and raised Him from the dead
2. He exalted Jesus as Lord and high priest
3. He revealed the gospel to His apostles and confirmed it by miracles

And Raised Him From The Dead

Mat 26:28 for this is My blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins.

Mat 26:32 "But after I have been raised, I will go ahead of you to Galilee."

Mar 15:33 When the sixth hour came, darkness fell over the whole land until the ninth hour.

Mar 15:34 At the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, "ELOI, ELOI, LAMA SABACHTHANI?" which is translated, "MY GOD, MY GOD, WHY HAVE YOU FORSAKEN ME?"

Mar 15:35 When some of the bystanders heard it, they began saying, "Behold, He is calling for Elijah."

Mar 15:36 Someone ran and filled a sponge with sour wine, put it on a reed, and gave Him a drink, saying, "Let us see whether Elijah will come to take Him down."

Mar 15:37 And Jesus uttered a loud cry, and breathed His last.

Mar 15:38 And the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom.

Mar 15:39 When the centurion, who was standing right in front of Him, saw the way He breathed His last, he said, "Truly this man was the Son of God!"

Joh 20:24 But Thomas, one of the twelve, called Didymus, was not with them when Jesus came.

Joh 20:25 So the other disciples were saying to him, "We have seen the Lord!" But he said to them, "Unless I see in His hands the imprint of the nails, and put my finger into the place of the nails, and put my hand into His side, I will not believe."

He Sent Jesus To Die For Our Sins

Joh 20:26 After eight days His disciples were again inside, and Thomas with them. Jesus \*came, the doors having been shut, and stood in their midst and said, "Peace be with you."

Joh 20:27 Then He \*said to Thomas, "Reach here with your finger, and see My hands; and reach here your hand and put it into My side; and do not be unbelieving, but believing."

Joh 20:28 Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!"

Joh 20:29 Jesus \*said to him, "Because you have seen Me, have you believed? Blessed are they who did not see, and yet believed."

Joh 20:30 Therefore many other signs Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book;

Joh 20:31 but these have been written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name.

## He Sent Jesus To Die For Our Sins And Raised Him From The Dead

Rom 3:24 being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;

Rom 3:25 whom God displayed publicly as a propitiation in His blood through faith. This was to demonstrate His righteousness, because in the forbearance of God He passed over the sins previously committed;

## He Sent Jesus To Die For Our Sins And Raised Him From The Dead

Rom 3:26 for the demonstration, I say, of His righteousness at the present time, so that He would be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus.

## He Sent Jesus To Die For Our Sins And Raised Him From The Dead

Rom 5:6 For while we were still helpless, at the right time Christ died for the ungodly.

Rom 5:7 For one will hardly die for a righteous man; though perhaps for the good man someone would dare even to die.

Rom 5:8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

## He Exalted Jesus As Lord And High Priest

Act 2:36 "Therefore let all the house of Israel know for certain that God has made Him both Lord and Christ--this Jesus whom you crucified."

## He Exalted Jesus As Lord And High Priest

Heb 7:25 Therefore He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

Heb 7:26 For it was fitting for us to have such a high priest, holy, innocent, undefiled, separated from sinners and exalted above the heavens;

## He Exalted Jesus As Lord And High Priest

Heb 7:27 who does not need daily, like those high priests, to offer up sacrifices, first for His own sins and then for the sins of the people, because this He did once for all when He offered up Himself.

Heb 7:28 For the Law appoints men as high priests who are weak, but the word of the oath, which came after the Law, appoints a Son, made perfect forever.

## He Revealed The Gospel To His Apostles And Confirmed It By Miracles

Joh 14:26 "But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.

Joh 16:13 "But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.

## Do Nothing Because God Will Save All

Rom 1:16 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.

2Th 1:8 dealing out retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.

## Do Nothing Because God Has Chosen Who Will Be Saved And Lost

Mar 16:15 And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation.

Mar 16:16 "He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved; but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned.

Act 2:40 And with many other words he solemnly testified and kept on exhorting them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation!"

## Live A Good Moral Life

Act 10:1 Now there was a man at Caesarea named Cornelius, a centurion of what was called the Italian cohort,

## I Must Believe In The Lord Jesus

Joh 3:16 "For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.
